Dr Robert Pope, Vice Principal and Director of Studies in Church History and Doctrine at Westminster College, Cambridge with the intriguing title for these days of "The Greatest Terror of Mankind": Contagion, the Church and the Providence of God"

**The "Dissenting Deputies"** were established as elected lay people, working with a body of Ministers, in 1732 to fight for the removal of restrictions which excluded the churches and people we now call in the "Free Church" tradition from many areas of public life. We maintain this annual society to honour their work. Free speech can never be taken for granted, enabling us to sustain our life, worship and witness. The body also keeps alive our historic right of direct approach to the Monarch.
