

Prayer Diary – March 2021



“Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?” Psalm 139:7

1	Monday As we enter a new month, pray people in prison will be able to open their hearts to all the things that God has planned for them.	9	Tuesday – Prayer Line request A asks us to pray for his release this week- he feels anxious going back to his old life and insecure housing. Pray for his girlfriend and children, that they will accept him
2	Tuesday Lord God, be with those in prison who are lonely or anxious. Ask that they may use <i>Prayer Line</i> to share their feelings, seek consolation, and receive blessings through prayer.	10	Wednesday As Covid-19 vaccines are rolled out, we pray that, to prevent further sickness and to bring peace of mind those we serve, everyone in prison will be vaccinated soon.
3	Wednesday - Prayer Line request B asks for prayer for strength and clarity when reading his Bible, and for protection in his life.	11	Thursday We give thanks to God for the care and wisdom of prison officers and chaplains who work tirelessly to support men and women serving sentences.
4	Thursday Pray for all Prison Fellowship volunteers, especially those who are unwell at this time. Ask God to give them healing and strength for continued ministry.	12	Friday – Prayer Line request D asks for prayer for his family, to keep them safe and healthy. Please pray that his release is straightforward and that he can settle back into life outside prison.
5	Friday Loving God, bless all those who have recently arrived in prison. Give them all they need as they begin their sentences.	13	Saturday Praise God for the generosity of our supporters. Give thanks for those who have donated towards <i>Angel Tree Mothers’ Day</i> .
6	Saturday Pray for those in prison receiving the “God our Rock and Redeemer” <i>Bible Study</i> this weekend. Ask that it helps them to listen to Jesus’s words and put them into practice.	14	Sunday – Mothering Sunday Ask the Lord to bless mothers and carers with a loved one in prison. Pray for mums receiving an <i>Angel Tree Mothers’ Day</i> card and gift from their child today.
7	Sunday Lord God, give courage and assurance to people in prison who have not seen their loved ones for many months, and who are worried for their families.	15	Monday God bless the PF Area Leaders who are meeting online today. Pray He will be the inspiration behind their work and collaboration.
8	Monday – International Women’s Day Today we remember the nearly 4,000 women in prison in England and Wales. Pray that God will heal them emotionally and spiritually, that they might find release from addiction, freedom from abuse, and hope for the future.	16	Tuesday Ask God to empower all people in prisons seeking renewal during this season of Lent. May they receive the grace of the Holy Spirit to be able to make a fresh start, turning their hearts fully towards God.

17	Wednesday Heavenly Father, please be with the Prison Fellowship Support Team this week. Grant them stamina and wisdom as they work to enable our ministry	24	Wednesday Give thanks to God for the hard work of the PF Trustees who steer the organisation. Pray that He will continue to guide them.
18	Thursday We remember everyone in prison who has lost a loved one to Covid-19 and not been able to say goodbye. Pray the presence of God and comfort of faith will console them in their grief.	25	Thursday – Prayer Line request G asks for prayer that God will fight for her. Pray for her family and that God helps her grow in her spiritual walk with Him. She also asks that we pray for her friend too – that God will intervene in both of their lives.
19	Friday Pray for <i>Bible Studies</i> , and the PF volunteers who meet today to plan the materials for Easter. Ask the Holy Spirit to breathe inspiration into their hearts and minds, so they can communicate God’s Word effectively.	26	Friday Remember Vulnerable Prisoners in your prayers today. Ask the Lord to give them strength and keep them safe.
20	Saturday Ask God to be with the children of prisoners today. May His gentle heart be in their play, thoughts, conversations and dreams so they feel His presence in their daily life.	27	Saturday – Prayer Line request L asks for prayers that he and his family keep safe and well. He asks for protection for NHS staff and prisoners suffering from mental health problems.
21	Sunday As we begin the first week of Spring, may new hope and fellowship surround those in prison, so that they may be witnesses of the love that is the promise of Easter.	28	Sunday – Palm Sunday We are reminded today of Jesus entering Jerusalem as the Prince of Peace. Pray for God’s peace throughout our prisons this Holy Week.
22	Monday – Prayer Line request L asks us to pray for her husband, that the light of God will shine on him and their four children. Pray too that their children will all come back together.	29	Monday Ask God to be with our CEO Peter this week as he directs the organisation. Thank the Lord for his wisdom and leadership.
23	Tuesday Ask God to be present to all those released from prison this month. May they have someone to welcome them through the gate, and a safe and secure roof over their heads.	30	Tuesday Intercede for those in our prisons who are experiencing poor mental health at this time. Ask God to draw close to them and bring them comfort.
		31	Wednesday – Prayer Line request C gives thanks for everyone who has been praying for him. He has been struggling lately and has found comfort in our prayers. He also give thanks for prison chaplains.
